**Digital Citizenship Mobile Learning**

The Digital Citizenship Mobile Learning research in partnership with the University of Calgary will continue for an additional six months. This is exciting news as teacher understanding of how these devices can support the personalization of learning continues to grow. As more schools in the project have their personal devices network activated new possibilities continue to emerge. The findings and lessons being generated in these classrooms will not only be part of the formal research created by the university but will inform the other schools and teachers as they move forward in mobile learning and the practice of digital citizenship.

The *Documentation of Learning* research began this month as three schools were equipped with a number of iPads. Unlike the Digital Citizenship Mobile Learning project not all students will be equipped with iPads. Rather the students will be exploring Reggio inspired inquiry projects and using the devices to demonstrate their thinking and learning. Teachers will use the devices to track students' progress as they learn. This initiative has the potential to help teachers support students as they are learning in a unique manner. CBE system support for these schools will extend past the end of the research.
